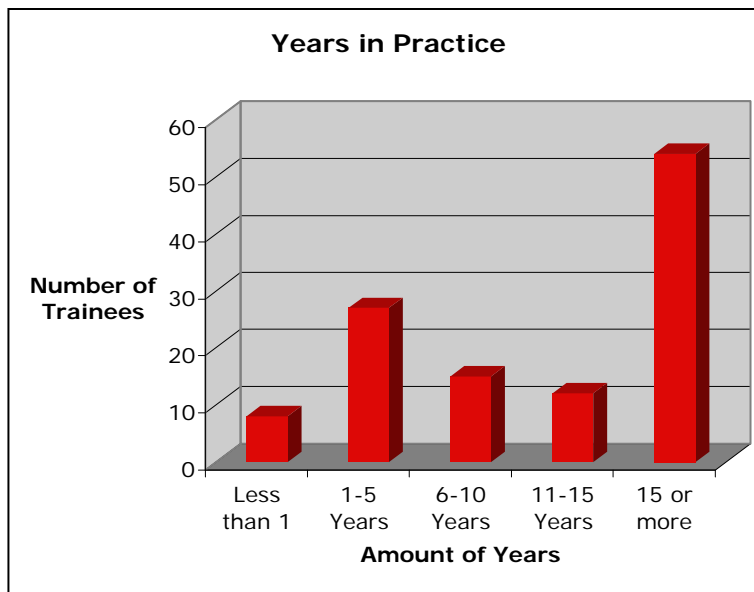
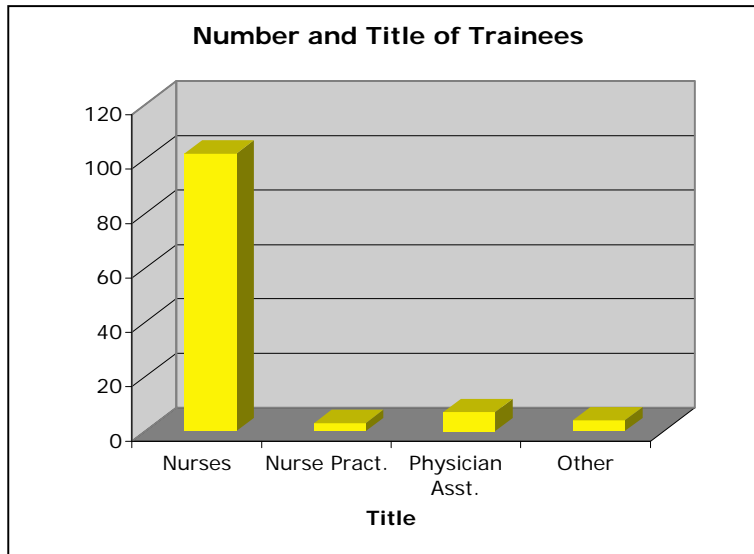


Results from Nurse Injector Competence Training May 2008

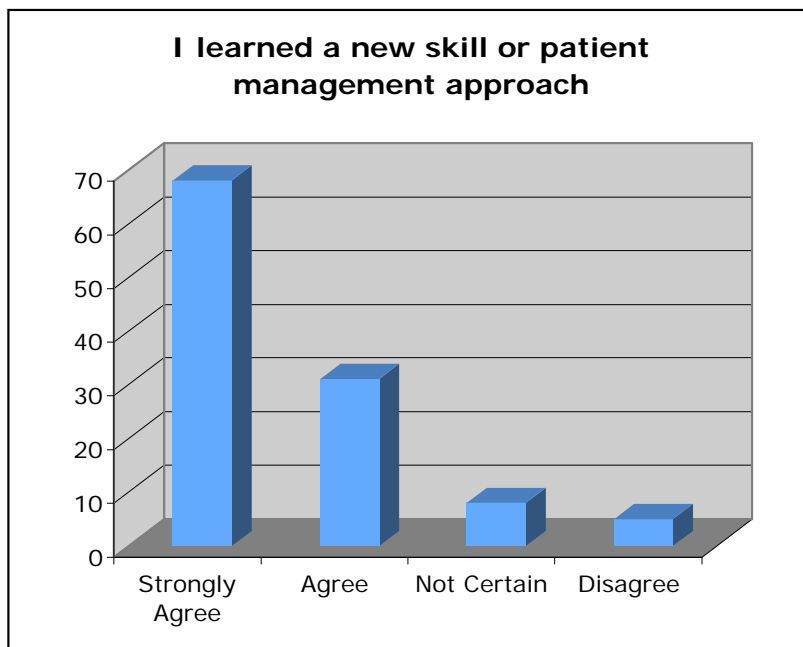

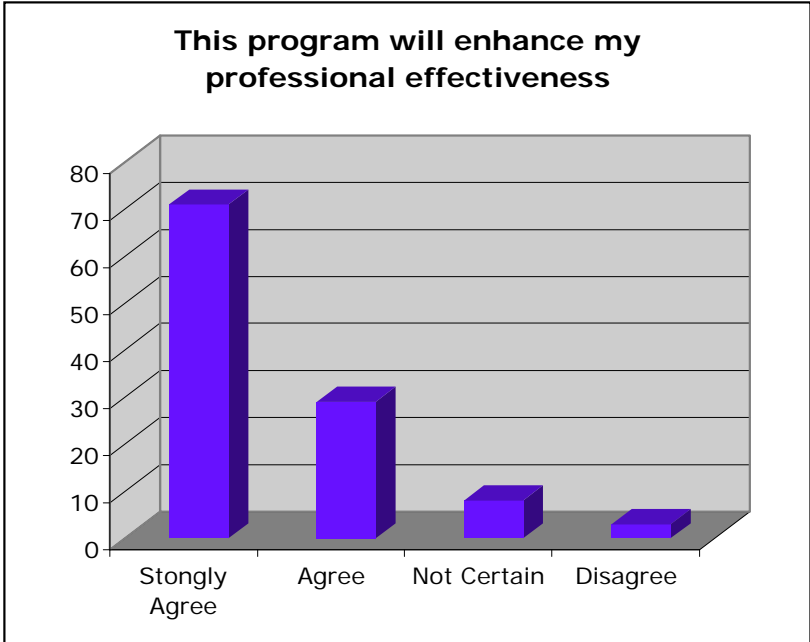

The following charts are actual data received at this seminar:

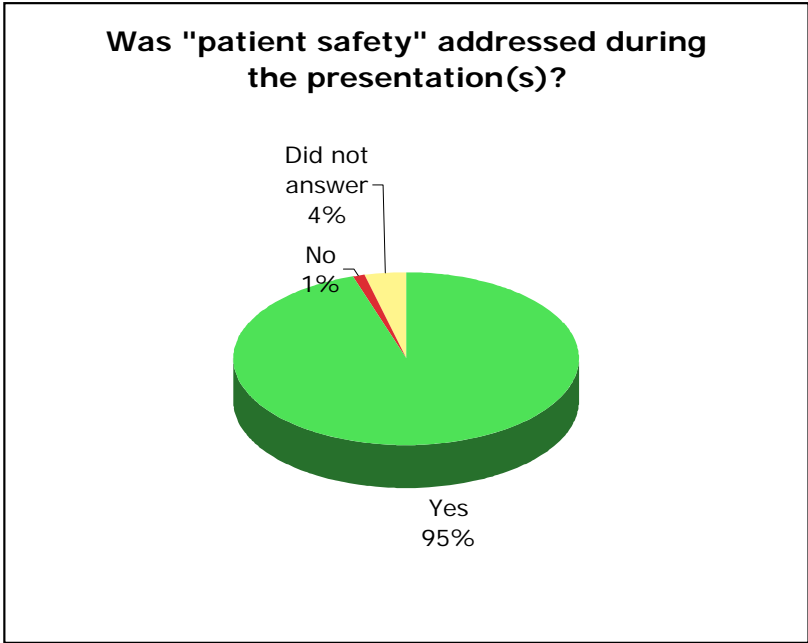
1. 88% of trainees would at least agree they learned something new at this session.

3. Most felt patient safety was clearly addressed.

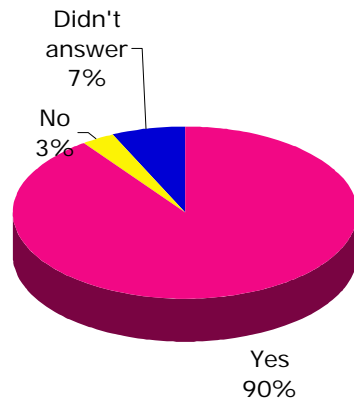
